## Merit Badge Request Form

This form must be turned in to the Scoutmaster (<u>Scoutmaster@Troop218.net</u>) and Mrs. Sandoval (<u>gtalvmo@me.com</u>) no later midnight on Saturday night, April 30<sup>th</sup> so that all Scouts can be signed up beginning on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Any Scouts that have not turned in their merit badge requests on time will have their merit badges requests entered as soon as practical following the Troop receiving the request.

**NOTE:** We will do everything we can so get Scouts registered for their merit badge, however, we cannot control the number of spots open in any given MB class.

Scouts who have not earned the rank of 1<sup>st</sup> class will be enrolled in the "Eagle Claw" program (normally called "Trail to First Class") to work on advancement. See Leader's Guide page 19 for rank requirements being taught during the "Eagle Claw" program. NOTE- This is a two-session class. No other Troop prerequisites will be necessary due to this being a two-session class (i.e., Scouts do not have to take 1<sup>st</sup> Aid if they don't choose to).
